REQUIREMENTS FOR CONFERENCE MATERIALS

The article and thesis must comprehensively reflect the author's perspectives on the research problem, offering specific scientific conclusions, practical proposals, and recommendations. Submissions are accepted in Uzbek, Karakalpak, Russian, and English.

Formatting guidelines are as follows: the document should be prepared in Microsoft Word with a line spacing of 1.5, using the Times New Roman font at size 14. The margins should be set to 2.0 cm at the top and bottom, 3.0 cm on the left, and 1.5 cm on the right. The text should be justified.

At the top of the article, centered on the page, the title should be written in capital letters. In the upper right corner, across the line, please include the following author information: surname, first name, place of work, academic

degree and title. For students, indicate the name of the university and the field of specialization, along with an email address.

The structure of the submission should be as follows: an abstract and keywords across the line, followed by the main text and a list of references.

Please note that the number of authors for each thesis should not exceed three (3). Each author may submit either theses or articles with a maximum author contribution of up to one (1) coefficient.

References (footnotes) should be provided at the bottom of each page. The total length of the thesis must be between 3 to 5 pages. Additionally, the title of the article must include the corresponding direction number (for example: 1-Sh.Sagdullayev).

Scientific articles and theses that do not meet the specified criteria will not be accepted. Authors bear full responsibility for the accuracy of examples, excerpts, and information presented in their submissions. The Organising Committee is under no obligation to return or provide feedback on works that are not accepted.

If the content of submitted abstracts aligns with the established requirements, they will be included in the conference proceedings and published on the official website of the Republican Scientific and Methodological Centre for Education Development (www.trm.uz), as well as on our social media platforms.
